TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER MAX KAST

High acid, medium body, medium alcohol. High intensity of aroma, notes of fresh grapefruit, tangerine, gooseberry, fresh green apple, secondary notes of sage, cilantro, lemongrass, parsley, green bell pepper, struck flint, button mushroom, and chalk. On the palate the wine is lean, with a long mineral finish.

TASTING NOTES BY: ADVANCED SOMMELIER BRANDON FORD

Pale yellow with flecks of green. Very aromatic with notes of tart citrus - lime, grapefruit, green apple and lemon. There are also grassy notes and struck match. The palate continues with fruit and the grassy notes expand to involve a bit of dandelion and jalapeno and a you get a flintiness as well. This wine see no new oak .

NOTES:

Sauvignon Blanc from Sancerre is unique for its combination of herbal and mineral aromatics and flavors. In the world of Sauvignon Blanc it is less aromatic than New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. It typically has less alcohol and is lighter-bodied than California Sauvignon Blanc, and has a different texture and aromatic profile than white Bordeaux (which is generally aged in oak and more often than not blended with Semillon). Some tasters confuse Sancerre with Albarino but with Albarino you have lower acid, more floral (Terpinic) notes, and more of a saline quality on the palate.
