This wine is pale straw in color with a watery rim and medium viscosity. There is no gas or sediment. The nose is developing- showing ripe citrus and stone fruit, green apple, orchard blossoms, and this continues on the palate. Along with that there is a high minerality - crushed stone/slate, no evidence of oak, dry, moderate alcohol and high acid. This wine is racey, lean, focused and precise.
