TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

Deep purple color, staining and tears. Fruit driven nose of black and blue fruits. On the palate there is ripe black berry, plum, purple cherry and blueberry fruit. Cocoa, mocha, coffee, and a slight herbal note are found here as well. Spice driven notes, indicate some oak usage. Creamy smooth palate.

TASTING NOTES BY: ADVANCED SOMMELIER BRANDON FORD

Deeply colored purple with what looks like a pink rim and staining on the glass. Ripe black and red fruit characters here, specifically, black raspberry, black cherry, blackberry, currant, and plum. Purple flowers and violets, with smoke, dark chocolate and coffee are precise on the palate.

NOTES:

Malbec gives deep purple staining wines. The ripe black fruits are rarely overblown, rarely jammy, and just perfectly overripe. And the roasted, toasted character is classic, along with a touch of oak. The structure and fruit profile steers us towards Bordeaux grape varieties. The ripeness puts us in the new world. The color points to purple varieties of Cabernet Franc and Malbec, while the floral and fruit profile makes us land on Malbec.
