Bright ruby with a hint of pink on the rim. The wine has beautiful dried red flowers with tart cranberry, cherry, and pomegranate - along with a hint of cola. There is a mineral character on the mid-palate as well as a nice character of dried mushroom. There is also a hint of spice from newer wood, but not that noticeable on the nose. The palate is fresh with round fruit, high acid, a vibrant freshness.
