Driven by citrus and orchard fruit. Racy acidity. Medium bodied. Balanced. Strong mineral component. Possible lees influence. Herbal notes in the background - thyme, mint.

NOTES :

The strong citrus and orchard fruit notes coupled with the high acidity and lack of prominent minerality leans towards Riesling from a cool climate, New World. Being dry, with the lack of oak, and absence of malolactic fermentation further point to Riesling. This could easily be confused with Alsatian Riesling.
