Medium plus intensity in aroma with ripe black plum, black cherry, black raspberry, and blueberry. Secondary notes of violets, cracked black pepper, cinnamon, clove, vanilla, toast points from aging in new French Oak. Round in texture with ripe tannins.

Pinotage is a very distinct grape. It was created in South Africa in 1925 and is a cross between Cinsault and Pinot Noir. Pinotage retains fresh fruit, never being jammy. The herbal and spicy notes are also characteristic of the grape, along with slight leathery notes.
