TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

Green apple, white peach, citrus blossom. This wine is precise and focused, but, delicate on the nose. Hints of blossomy flowers, without being floral. Minty green notes. Strong minerality. No Oak.

TASTING NOTES BY: ADVANCED SOMMELIER JOSHUA CARLSEN

Water-white, and bright. High intensity of orchard fruits (green apple, pear), stone fruits (peach, nectarine), and citrus. Slight sulphuric note. Orchard blossoms. Highly mineral - slate/crushed stones.

Other: The Leistenberg vineyard lies in a

small side valley of the Nahe. The name is a play on words. Leisten means achieve in German

NOTES:

Very few wines in the wine world are off-dry, despite the common misuse of the term "dry wine". So, when we discuss quality wines, it really comes down to two wines that fall into this category: Loire chenin and German (NOT ALSAGE OR AUSTRIA!!!) riesling. In this case, the quality of the fruit and the delicacy of the wine are distinctively Riesling and not Chenin Blanc. Also take note of the low alcohol.
