NOTES:

This wine is clearly aromatic. Combined with the acid profile (it feels like it wants to rip the enamel off my teeth) makes this riesling. So where from? Germany, Austria, Alsace, or New World (Australia, California, Oregon). The ripeness level is a key here. The fruit seems a little too ripe to be old world. So we end up in the new world. At this point we have to look at the acid level, and the acid and dryness is indicative of Australian Riesling. The acid is high, while not having any richer notes like in Alsace. Not as herbal as spicy and herbal as Austrian riesling, and not as mineral driven as Trocken German riesling,
