Deep purple core, with notable staining. The nose is dominated by savory notes. Ripe and tart black fruit, currant, plum and black berry. Purple flowers, grilled herbs, pepper, olive, smoked meat and strong mineral components. Fruit turns tart on the palate. Little to no sign of oak.

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## NOTES :

Syrah gives purple (sometimes red) colors, and is known to be dominated by savory notes, specifically bacon, pepper and olive. Northern Rhone will have more savory aspects and will show less fruit than New World Syrah. Southern Rhone Syrah blends tend to be higher in alcohol and will have a that raisin like note along with the fruit.
