**Grape:** Assyrtiko  
**Country:** Greece

**Elevage:** Aged in stainless steel tanks

**Winemaking:** The grapes used for Estate Argyros Assyrtiko are harvested from the oldest parcels of the estate. Located in Episkopi, the average age of the vines is 150+ years old with some vines over 3 centuries old.

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## NOTES :

The elevated acidity and alcohol is not common for a white grape, that added with the texture/phenolics are telltale assyrtiko.
