See through red core, with no browning. This wine smells like all forms of cherries first and foremost. Red and black, sweet and tart, and even bordering on cherry cola. There is a red floral note, some slight green herbal notes (like crushed green leaves), and a cola/licorice like spicy notes. Some bakng spice and vanilla indicates some new oak use.
