Very few wines in the wine world are off-dry, despite the common misuse of the term "dry wine". So, when we discuss quality wines, it really comes down to two wines that fall into this category: loire chenin and german (NOT ALSACE OR AUSTRIA!!!) riesling. In this case, the quality of the fruit and the delicacy of the wine are distinctively riesling. Also of note: low alcohol.
