TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

See through, but surprisingly purple with no browning. The nose is immediately ripe cherry driven, with notes or candied tart fruits. The herbal, green crushed leaf, licorice/cola like spice is strong, and there is a SLIGHT mineral Note. The wine shows spice and vanilla notes.

TASTING NOTES BY: ADVANCED SOMMELIER JOSHUA CARLSEN

Medium concentration of ruby-red with medium viscosity. Driven by red fruit aromas and flavors of cherries, raspberries, and red plum skin. These are backed up by dried herbs, tea, and red flowers along with a subtle earthiness. This wine shows fine grained tannins and juicy acidity. There is spice and vanilla here as well indicating oak.

While the fruit and palate roundness scream pinot, the purple color is unique to high UV radiations areas (like Patagonia and Otago). Its rare to see purple like this in pinot unless another grape like Syrah has been blended in, but, UV radiation will cause purple colors to appear.
