TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER THOMAS PRICE

Medium concentration of pale straw with green inflections. Medium tears. Medium plus intensity of aromas - cut grass, bell pepper, savory herbal notes. The fruit is tart and underripe. Grapefruit, lemon/lime, green apple, melon rind, hints of underripe tropical fruit. Slight white flowers. Highly mineral and chalky. Crushed stones. No evidence of new oak.

TASTING NOTES BY: F.L.X. TABLE'S JOSH CARLSEN

This wine shows a pale straw in the glass with hints of green. Moderate viscosity. No evidence of gas or sediment. On the nose, the wine is fresh and bright with medium plus intensity dominated by citrus and herbal notes. Tart citrus notes of grapefruit and lemon accompany underripe pear and just-ripe white peach with a hint of tropical fruit. Cut grass, nettles, and green bell pepper are strongly evident along with wet/crushed stones and chalk. There is a slight note of citrus blossoms. There is no evidence of oak.
