Purple color, vibrant rim, but see-through. Ripe and tart black fruits; cassis, plum, blackberry. Purple flowers, crushed gravel, pencil shavings, graphite and herbal, bell pepper notes.

TASTING NOTES BY: F.L.X. TABLE'S JOSH CARLSEN

The wine shows a medium concentration of purple/ruby and is see-through with a medium viscosity. No evidence of gas or sediment. The nose is of moderate intensity showing ripe and under-ripe/slightly tart black fruits – black currant, plum, and blackberry. There are purple flowers and green/vegetal notes as well as crushed stone/gravel, graphite, and cedar/pencil shavings. There is also a loamy earth quality.
