TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

Purple, see through and pink rim. candied tart fruits, red cranberry, strawberry, pomegranate notes on the nose. purple fruits, slight pepper note, but really dominated by the fruits, and crushed rock minerality.

TASTING NOTES BY: F.L.X. TABLE'S DANIEL PENDLETON

This is a clear red wine of pale concentration of ruby with secondary colors of red and ruby and no rim variation. No signs of gas or sediment, moderate tears. On the nose there is slight barnyard notes indicating Brettanomyces, but it adds to the complexity of the wine. Moderate plus intensity of youthful aromas. Fruits are ripe and red: red cherry, red cranberry, red raspberry and pomegranate. Light red flowers, light green herbs, green peppercorn indicating possible stem inclusion. Banana peel, confectioned fruit notes indicating possible carbonic maceration. Button mushroom, turned wet earth, forest floor. No signs of new oak. On the palate fruits are tart and red. More fresh herbs on the palate and more turned earth on the palate. No oak. Tannin is moderate and coarse, acid is moderate plus, alcohol is moderate. Medium body with a lean texture
