TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

Ruby core, pink rim, see through. Ripe red and black cherries, some sour, and almost cherry cola like aromas. Red flowers, turned earth, potting soil, forest floor and pine like aromas give way to spice, vanilla and toast from new oak. Stays ripe on the palate.

TASTING NOTES BY: F.L.X. TABLE'S DANIEL PENDLETON

This is a clear red wine, clean, with pale concentration of ruby with secondary colors of red and ruby, light rim variation, no signs of gas or sediment. Moderate plus tears. On the nose the wine is clean with moderate plus intensity of youthful aromas. Fruits are overripe and red: red cherry, red cranberry and red strawberry. Red flowers, rose. Rosemary and light green herbs. Black tea, cola, dried mushroom, pine forest floor, dry turned earth. Nutmeg, toast, vanilla indicated new French oak aging. On the palate the fruits are the same and stay overripe with more toast and oak notes.

Sweetness: Dry

Tannin: Moderate minus
Alcohol: Moderate plus
Acid: Moderate plus
Oak: Evidence of new oak
