TASTING NOTES BY: MASTER SOMMELIER CHRISTOPHER BATES

Pale straw, with green inflections. This wine smells like ripe apple, white peach and lemon lime notes. The wine has a light blossom like florality, crushed rock, minty nose, with hints of green. No oak. The palate shows ripe fruit and noticeable sweetness. This wine is off dry. The palate is similar to the nose. Alc. Low. Acid-High. Phenolic-Now. Off Dry.

TASTING NOTES BY: F.L.X. TABLE'S JOSH CARLSEN

This white is pale straw with green highlights. Moderate concentration. The nose has a high intensity of aromas. Ripe yellow apple, quince, lemon/lime, and nectarine. There is white floral/citrus blossom note as well. The wine shows high levels of minerality – slate, crushed rock – as well as slight smoky note and hints of petrol.
